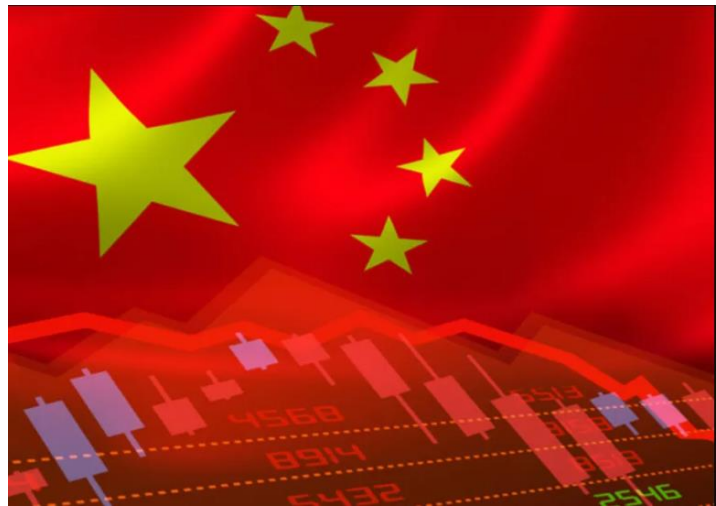


Economic Contributions and South-South Cooperation
