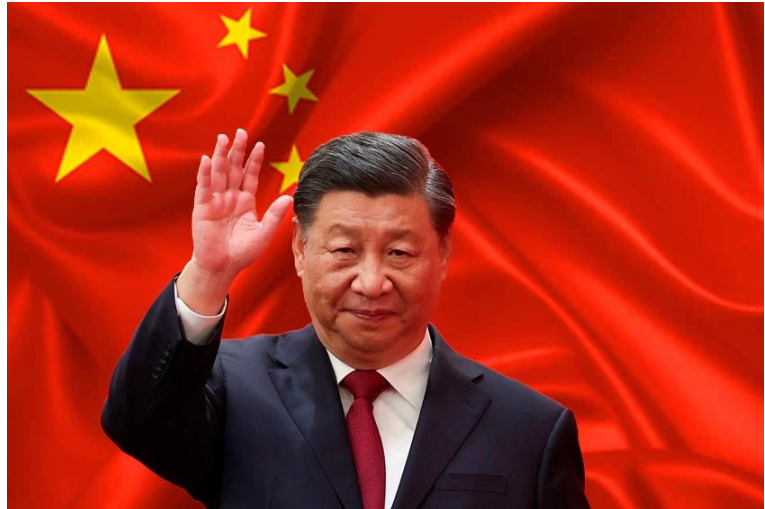


demonstrating how to create ample development opportunities and build a community that benefits all of humanity.
