







## <u>Dushanbe Conference on International & Regional Border</u> <u>Security and Management Cooperation for Counter</u> Terrorism

In contemporary times, international and regional border security cooperation has become increasingly important to seek protection from non-state actors. In this regard, the two-day

high-level conference will be held at Dushanbe, Tajikistan on 18-19 October 2022 in collaboration with UNOCT and other significant partners.

The Tajik government is leaving no stone unturned to



make the conference an important event of the year. The conference holds much relevance for promoting bilateral, sub-regional, regional, and international cooperation. Under the exceptional leadership of President Emomali Rahmon, Tajikistan has emerged as a potential stakeholder for regional cooperation, peace, and joint collaboration. The platform calls for an open dialogue between regional stakeholders, security agencies, agencies, international organizations and experts. The discussions will focus on the most topical issues of security under the auspice of international and regional security laws. Moreover, the Conference will include a High-Level Opening Session with the participation of the President of the Republic of Tajikistan H.E. Mr. Emomali Rahmon, Secretary-General of the United Nations H.E. Mr. António Guterres, Under-Secretary-General of UNOCT Mr. Vladimir Voronkov, and a number of Government Ministers and other senior officials from the region and abroad. It is also anticipated that the two-day International Dushanbe Conference will conclude with the adoption of the Dushanbe





Declaration on Border Security and Management Cooperation to Counter Terrorism and Prevent the Movement of Terrorists.
