Digital Economy and Information Technology (IT):

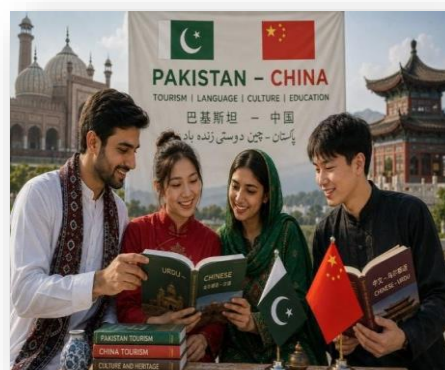
