The recent Summit of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) in 2024 in Islamabad the host country of Pakistan, affirmatively promoted the idea of regional

cooperation. Different leaders of the member states meet to make their points regarding contentious issues such as security, development, and stability of the region. This summit, the first Pakistan has



organized for this regional organization having earned the status of a full member of SCO, was indicative of its desire to bolster relations and cooperation with countries. It reiterated a joined-up approach to managing the current global challenges including terrorism, economic disparities, climatic change, and the international food needs. States' engagement was evident from member states such as the People's Republic of China, the Russian Federation, India, the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Kyrgyz Republic, the Republic of Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan as well as observer states.

The Shanghai Cooperation Organization is now an important regional organization that connects different nations of Eurasia for the sake of peace, stable development, and prosperity. Due to increasing cooperation, the SCO is not only a member-based strategic partnership but also a sign of collaboration and where different nations are gathering to discuss concerns. The choice of Islamabad to host the Summit in 2024 signifies a





moment of pride for Pakistan given its proactive. Maximizing opportunities to engage with its neighbors objectively makes Pakistan ready and willing to host such a role as a region's peacemaker given the rising global insecurities. This summit is timely to be held at this time when alliances are shifting, economies are unstable, and new threat scenery emerges. They have been made by understandable and well-defined objectives that are geared towards advancing the spirit of cooperation, dialogue, and shared growth in the UAE, Pakistan, and around the world. It is not simply a matter of responding to current problems but of creating the conditions in which regional countries may be able to address them and manage opportunities in the future. This merges incredibly well with the fundamental principles of the SCO framework, which revolves around friendship, mutual understanding, non-interference in one another's affairs, and harmonious development. The summit is not just another event for Pakistan it is an opportunity for the country to recreate and reaffirm its place in the strategic thinking of the region's future.

The foreign leaders visited Pakistan to attend the Summit, including the Chinese Premier Li Qiang, Kyrgyz Prime Minister Akylbek Zhaparov, Belarusian Prime Minister Roman Golovchenko, and Tajik Prime Minister Kokhir Rasulzoda. The foreign minister of India, S Jaishankar also appeared for his country as part of the cooperation that remains active within the SCO platform.Rashid Meredov, the Foreign Minister of Turkmenistan, is also in charge of the Cabinet of Ministers. The summit was also attended by heads of delegations of the Prime Minister of Russia, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan and Mongolia, vice





President of Iran, and others. They underscored the importance of the SCO as the union that unites the major actors of world geopolitics.

The SCO still advocates for security as one of its primary values, and the 2024 summit

followed this tradition. In this context, the proliferation of new forms and types of threats such as terrorism, drug trafficking, mass, and cybercrime requires concerted action. These two



factors make Pakistan an important player in these talks; it is located in a very strategic region besides having a wealth of experience in counter-terrorism. However, Pakistan has always spoken in responsibility of a collective approach to address these challenges. Through hosting the summit our common goal of intelligence-sharing, cooperation in military drills, and defined counter-terrorism measures were underlined.

Besides security cooperation, the SCO has the most promising economic partnership. The Eurasian area is endowed with some of the most plentiful resources in the world and therefore, affords broad opportunities for both trade and investment. Analyzing the BRI, the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) is the most famous project of it. CPEC in its essence is more of a bilateral diplomacy, however, in its extended sense it is a platform that connects SCO through trade corridors, economic cooperation, and investment in infrastructure. Pakistan encouraged others to look at the CPEC as a door to





new potential in connection to regional integration. Another factor that the summit wanted to address was Cultural exchange. Periodically, especially within the context of the SCO, the role of culture as an instrument for reconciliation and cooperation has been well understood by the SCO members. Since Pakistan is a country with a great cultural and historical background for centuries, it did appreciate a chance to speak about its culture but at the same time, the cultural diversity of other member states. Festivals and cultural performances also graced the summit and the so dominating objective of creating and fostering mutual respect was realized. These are not only perfunctory; they signify a far greater bond that transcends the politics and economics of an exchange whose primary is the building of relationships with uses for business longevity.

As globalization slowly changes its pace, cities, and countries seek new friends, and sources to address global issues. The SCO, with its open-door policy and a rich vision, is that forum. Pakistan, being cognizant of these changes, was quite active in influencing the nature of the summit which should reflect present problems as well as future potential. Climate change and sustainable development, technological innovation, infrastructure, and many other topics show that the discussions represent a multi-faceted view of the region's development. It's been the policy of the SCO to be embraced, and this summit was no exception. Since then, the organization has allowed observer states and dialogue partners and has continued to expand the conversation. Through its diplomacy, Pakistan has played a role in the SCO the forum remained open to discussions and includes new voices. Such openness is imperative in an area where reliability appears





to depend on the flexibility of addressing several parties. The 2024 summit looked into ways of cementing these relations and building a sense of unity and destiny among them.
