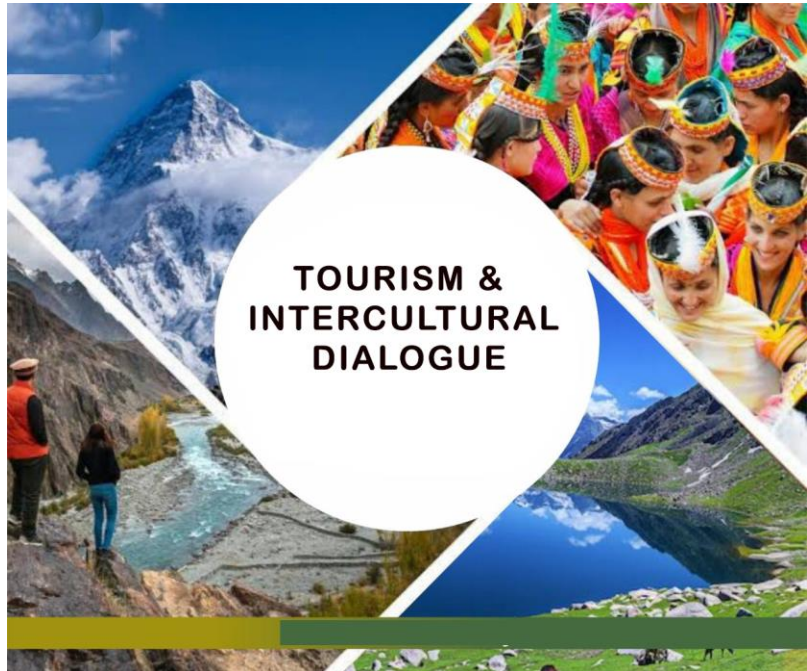
**Promoting Tourism to Connect People and its role in
