Achieving these goals is vital for a more equitable and sustainable world. The United Nations and organizations like the World Bank Group have been working together with the BRI. They provide information and help countries make smart decisions about BRI projects. The World Bank Group, for example, did a study in June 2019 called "Belt and Road Economics." It showed that BRI transport projects can make trade easier, bring in more investments, and reduce poverty. If everything goes as planned, these transport projects could increase global trade by up to 6.2 percent and boost global income by up to 2.9 percent, benefiting many countries. The United Nations, along with many organizations, is working together with the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) to help achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). One important partner in this effort is the World Bank Group. They've done studies to understand how the BRI affects things like trade, investment, debt, the environment, and making life better for people by reducing poverty. Their research is like a flashlight, helping us see how the BRI connects to these important issues. Another example of this is in 2019, when the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) collaborated with Ethiopia's Investment Commission (EIC) to initiate a project that promoted sustainable investments. Its primary objective was to



enhance Ethiopia's appeal to foreign investments aligned with the country's development objectives, particularly in sectors like energy and infrastructure. This project brought together the Ethiopian government, the private sector, and development agencies, all working collectively to eliminate barriers to sustainable investments with a strong focus on environmental and social concerns.

Moreover, a significant achievement of this endeavor was the establishment of a Sustainable Investment Promotion (SIP) facility. It encouraged cooperation and ensured investment promotion strategies aligned with Ethiopia's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). In 2020, to enhance information dissemination, an SIP Information Platform was created. It provided timely information, especially during challenging times like the COVID-19 pandemic. Initiatives like these underscored the importance of collaboration, and sustainability in global development. They offered valuable insights in promoting sustainable growth worldwide. The BRI, if executed effectively, can contribute to in a much greater way having a much greater impact on world economics and sustainability. In addition to the World Bank Group's research, various countries along the Belt and Road have also recognized the





potential of this initiative to create economic opportunities. Many have welcomed the infrastructure development and connectivity that the BRI brings, seeing it as a chance to boost their own economies trade relationships. For instance, countries in Asia and Europe have witnessed improved transport links, making it easier to export and import goods, ultimately spurring economic growth .Moreover, the BRI places great emphasis on green and sustainable practices. China has been working to incorporate environmentally friendly technologies and practices into its BRI projects. This commitment aligns with the global push to address climate change and environmental concerns, further enhancing the initiative's positive impact on sustainable development.
