Turkmenistan Hosts International Forum on the

Interconnection of Civilizations for Global Peace and

Development

The International Forum "Interconnection of Times and Civilizations—the Basis of Peace and Development," held on 11 October 2024, in Ashgabat, Turkmenistan, marked the celebration of the 300th anniversary of the birth of the great Turkmen poet and thinker, Magtymguly Fragi. was to highlight how cultural and historical interconnections embodied by figures like Magtymguly can form the basis for peaceful coexistence and development in today's globalized world. Scholars and officials from various countries discussed his influence not just on Turkmenistan but on world literature, pointing to the poet's humanistic vision that transcended borders. The inclusion of Magtymguly's 300th anniversary in the UNESCO List of Memorable Dates, as well as the addition of his manuscripts to the International Memory of the World Register, highlights the global significance of his works.

Outcomes of the Forum

The discussions at the forum resulted in several key outcomes, all of which underscore the role of cultural heritage in fostering peace and mutual understanding:

- The forum emphasized the need to popularize the national traditions and cultural heritage of various nations, especially among the younger generation. The participants highlighted the importance of fostering an interest in national creativity and cross-cultural understanding, which serves as a foundation for peaceful relations between countries.
- Participants noted the extensive translation of Magtymguly's works into multiple languages and their publication worldwide. They advocated for further efforts to promote his literary contributions, including plans for an "Encyclopedia of Magtymguly Fragi" that would serve as a comprehensive resource for scholars and readers interested in his legacy.





- The forum called for deeper cooperation in studying and disseminating Magtymguly's literary works, noting that such efforts contribute to the preservation of cultural heritage. By sharing these works globally, Turkmenistan aims to foster greater understanding between nations, ultimately contributing to global peace.
- The participants emphasized that the poet's legacy represents an invaluable contribution of the Turkmen people to world culture. His poetry, steeped in love for his homeland and respect for universal human values, continues to inspire people globally.
- The forum concluded that cultural dialogue, particularly in relation to the works of great thinkers like Magtymguly Fragi, significantly contributes to international cooperation. The participants agreed to support further initiatives aimed at promoting his legacy through conferences, exhibitions, and creative evenings.
