


<u>"Pakistan-China All-Weather Friends: 70 Years of Exceptional Partnership"</u> 27th May 2021






"Culture: Exploring New Frontier of Sino-Pakistan Friendship" 28th July 2021






Young Scholars' Debate 4th September 2021

On 4th September 2021, Young scholars' debate on 70 Years of Pak-China Diplomatic Relations was organized by Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future, Islamabad. Young analysts and researchers shared their analysis on different themes.
