


Gwadar's Economic Boom: Xinning Enterprise (Shenzhen) Ltd, China Signs Expression of Interest to invest in Gwadar Port Authority

05 August 2025



On August 5, 2025, a high-level five-member Chinese business delegation from the All-China Federation of Industry and Commerce (ACFIC) and Precise Development (HK) Limited, is currently visiting Pakistan. During their visit, an Expression of Interest (EOI) was signed by Xinning Enterprise (Shenzhen) Ltd. for commercial engagement with the Gwadar Port Authority (GPA).

The was signed under the leadership of under the leadership of Federal Minister for Maritime Affairs, Muhammad Junaid Anwar Chaudhry, along with officials from the Ministry of Maritime Affairs and the Chairman of the Gwadar Port Authority (GPA). On the Chinese side, Mr. Yi Jiang, Director of All-China Federation of Industry and Commerce (ACFIC), and Mr. David Chu, CEO of Precise Development (HK) Limited, China were also present.



Key components of this Expression of Interest include the utilization of Gwadar Port as a regional transshipment hub by Xinning Enterprise. They intend to establish a slaughterhouse and meat processing facility, as well as develop a modern deep-sea fishing industry to bolster Pakistan's



On 20 August 2025, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram opened NEWSROOM with an analysis of the 6th Trilateral meeting in Kabul between China, Afghanistan and Pakistan. Leaders focused on joint counter-terrorism, health, education and anti-drug-trafficking efforts, as well as extending the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor into Afghanistan. They pledged to deepen security cooperation—Pakistan offering its counter-terrorism expertise, China supporting Afghan bus manufacturing—and to pursue regional infrastructure projects like CPAC and the Trans-Afghan Railway. The Kabul administration also agreed not to impede Pakistan’s cross-border operations against militant safe havens.

In the second segment, Mr. Akram discussed Pakistan’s Economic Coordination Committee, which approved a Rs5.88 billion flood relief package, immediately releasing Rs4 billion. He warned that climate-driven flash floods—exacerbated by deforestation and poor governance in both countries—demand urgent policy reforms. These include stricter river management laws, community early warning systems, and a regional climate strategy under the Shanghai Cooperation Organization.
