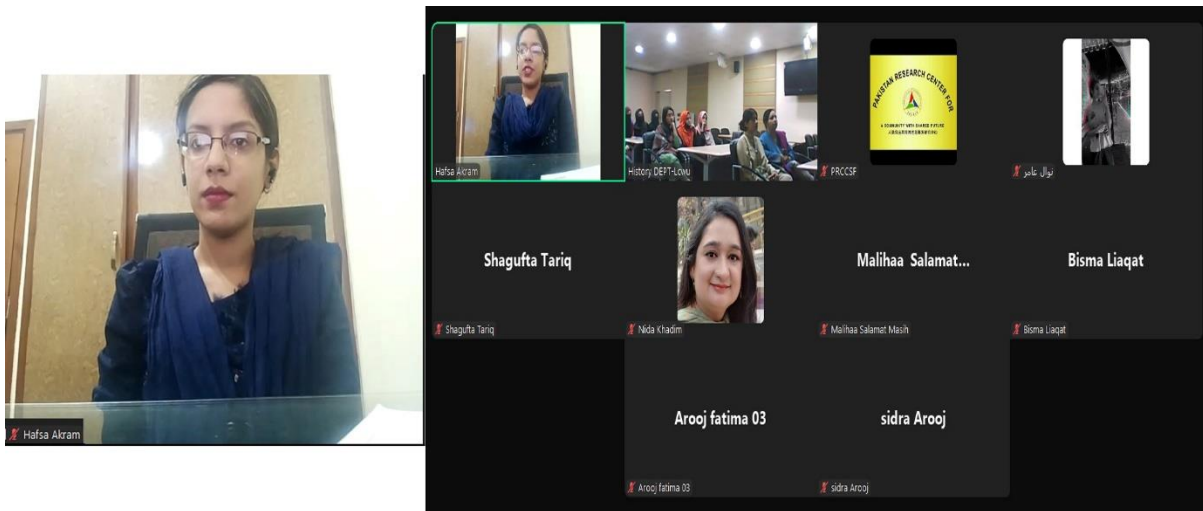

Central–South Asia Connectivity through CPEC: Training Session of Lahore College for Women University (LCWU) Fellows

4 December 2024



On 4th December 2024, as part of a joint fellowship program, Ms. Hafsa Akram, Research Head of Fellowship Program led a captivating Training Session at Lahore College for Women University (LCWU) in Lahore. During the session, Ms. Hafsa shared valuable insights on the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) and its potential for economic integration by providing access to Central Asia’s rich energy resources and direct routes to the Arabian Sea for landlocked nations.

The seminar commenced with a warm welcome from Dr. Fouzia Hadi Ali, Director Regional Integration Centre, University of the Punjab, Lahore. In her opening address, she expressed her heartfelt gratitude to the distinguished guests and experts from China, acknowledging their

Prof. Dr. Iram Khalid, Dean Faculty of Behavioral & Social Sciences/Chairperson, Department of Political Science, University of the Punjab, Lahore delivered a compelling discourse on the strategic infrastructure projects associated with the BRI and their significant impact on global trade routes. She highlighted the importance of these projects in reshaping trade dynamics and fostering economic corridors.

In a thought-provoking presentation, Prof. Dr. Sajid Rashid Ahmad, Dean of GeoSciences at the College of Earth and Environmental Sciences at the University of the Punjab, Lahore

addressed China's efforts to promote a clean and green environment within the ambit of the BRI. His remarks focused on sustainable development practices that aim to balance economic growth with environmental stewardship.

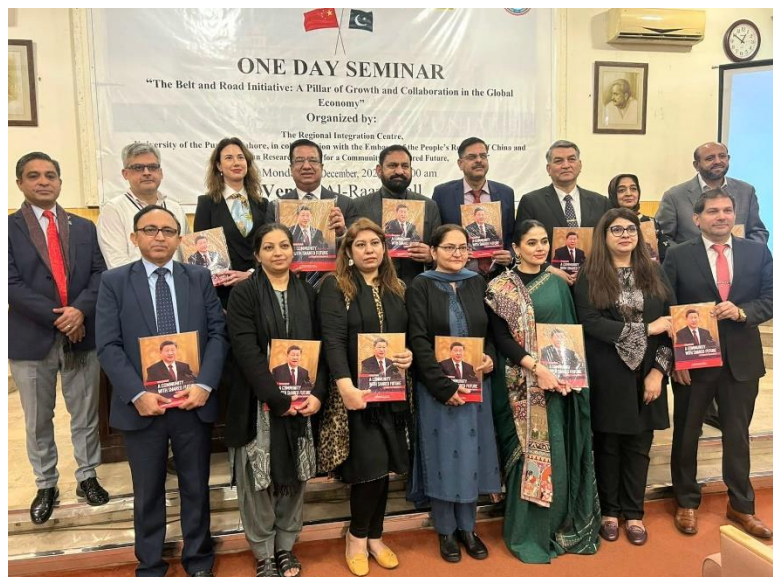
Dr. Khurram S. Joya, IUM, KSA University of Engineering and Technology (UET), Lahore

RoundTable Discussion on "Judicial Silk Route Proposed to Strengthen Legal Collaboration Under CPEC and BRI" co-organized by the Institute of Regional Studies (IRS) and the Centre for Chinese Legal Studies at LUMS in Islamabad

5 November 2024



A consultative roundtable titled “A Holistic Assessment of Legislative Reform, Investment Protection, and Dispute Resolution under CPEC” was held in Islamabad, co-organized by the Institute of Regional Studies (IRS) and the Centre for Chinese Legal Studies at LUMS. The event brought together prominent legal and policy experts, including Honourable Justice Mansoor Ali Shah and Justice Jawad Hassan, to discuss strengthening legal mechanisms under the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) and the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC).

Judicial Silk Route Initiative

Justice Mansoor Ali Shah proposed the establishment of a “Judicial Silk Route” between China and South Asia to enhance legal collaboration and create efficient dispute resolution mechanisms. He emphasized adopting advanced legal frameworks inspired by Chinese practices and called for the



creation of BRI commercial mediation centers and domestic commercial courts in Pakistan. These measures, he noted, would facilitate investment protection, streamline dispute resolution, and make Pakistan more investor-friendly by reducing its reliance on traditional litigation.

Strengthening Legal Frameworks for CPEC

Justice Jawad Hassan highlighted Pakistan’s legal advancements in supporting CPEC, which is now entering its third phase. He praised the establishment of the Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC) as a confidence-boosting measure for investors. Justice Hassan also underscored the importance of alternative dispute resolution (ADR) mechanisms, such as arbitration and mediation, in resolving complex legal challenges in large-scale infrastructure projects.



He lauded Pakistan’s accession to the Singapore Convention on Mediation, describing it as a progressive step toward reinforcing ADR practices and fostering international investment confidence.

Strategic Importance of Legal and Institutional Development

Mr. Khalid Taimoor Akram, Executive Director of the Pakistan Research Centre for a Community with Shared Future, emphasized Pakistan’s strategic location as a transit route for China and Central Asian states. However, he highlighted the absence of a comprehensive legal framework and ADR mechanisms, urging the establishment of dedicated facilities to address disputes efficiently.



Ambassador Jauhar Saleem, President of IRS, expressed concerns over Pakistan’s institutional capacity to handle complex legal contracts for large-scale projects. He stressed the urgent need to enhance legal and institutional frameworks to eliminate ambiguities and ensure the effective implementation of CPEC initiatives.

Building Trust and Addressing Policy Challenges

Dr. Sikander Ahmed Shah, Director of the Centre for Chinese Legal Studies at LUMS, emphasized the broader significance of the Pakistan-China partnership. Beyond infrastructure, he noted that the collaboration represents shared values and mutual trust, urging both nations to tackle legal and policy challenges to secure the partnership’s long-term success.

Other speakers included Dr. Tariq Mahmood, a barrister and arbitrator, who discussed international arbitration standards, and Ms. Riffat Inam Butt, Secretary of the Law and Justice Commission of Pakistan,



who stressed judicial efficiency and policy alignment to attract investments and sustain growth.

Other notable contributions included Mr. Shahid Mehmood Khokhar, Chairman, Implementation Tribunal for Newspaper Employees (ITNE), Mr. Aziz Qazi, Advocate Supreme Court and Vice Chairman of the Islamabad Bar Council, Advocate Supreme Court Raja Muqsit Nawaz, Barrister Zopash Khan, Mr. Muzaffar Ahmed Mirza, Chief Prosecutor and Head of Legal Affairs at the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP), Mr. Ashfaq Ahmad Khan, Deputy Inspector General of Police and Commandant of Police College Sihala (PCS), Barrister Minaal Tariq, Advocate Sibah Farooq and Mr .Shozab Majeed , legal Expert.

Key Takeaways

The event, attended by judges, policymakers, legal scholars, and industry leaders, concluded with discussions on shaping the strategic direction of CPEC Phase II. It underscored the critical need for robust legal reforms, investment protection measures, and dispute resolution

mechanisms to support Pakistan’s economic and infrastructural development under CPEC and BRI.

The event was moderated by Ms Minahil Toor , Lead Expert, Centre for Chinese Legal Studies, LUMS.

The roundtable served as a platform for collaborative dialogue, aiming to align Pakistan’s legal and institutional frameworks with international standards and foster a more investor-friendly environment.

The inaugural session included an address by His Excellency Ilham Aliyev, President of Republic of Azerbaijan, delivered by Prof. Adalat Valiyev, Head of the Department for Relations with Political Parties and Legislative Authority of the Presidential Administration of the Republic of Azerbaijan. In recent years, thanks to Uzbekistan’s proactive regional policy, Central Asia has become consolidated, stable and sustainable, becoming one of the important centres of economic growth and regaining its historical role in connecting the West with the East and the North with the South.

Today, more than 10 international transport corridors pass through the territory of Central Asian countries, including 3 of the 5 corridors of the Eurasian transport framework: the Central Eurasian Corridor, TRACECA and the Eastern Route of the ITC “North-South”. In addition, the process of implementing new railway corridors has begun, such as “China - Kyrgyzstan – Uzbekistan”, “Uzbekistan - Afghanistan –

Pakistan”, as well as multimodal corridors “Uzbekistan – Turkmenistan – Iran – Turkiye” and “Belarus – Russia – Kazakhstan – Uzbekistan – Afghanistan – Pakistan” for the development of trade between Asia – Europe and North – South.

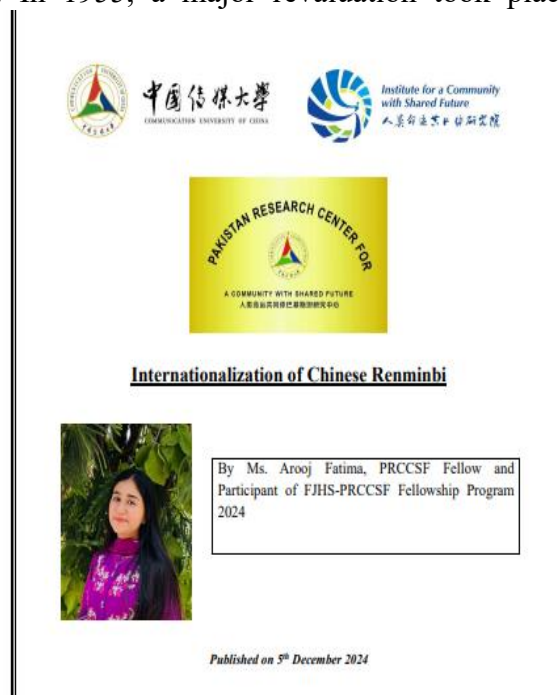

Renminbi (RMB) in the literal sense means “people’s currency”, was introduced in 1948 as the official currency of China, by the people’s Bank of China. It was done soon after the People’s Republic of China came into being. In 1955, a major revaluation took place, introducing a new version of the yuan at an exchange rate of 1 new yuan for 10,000 old yuan. The renminbi has since evolved, with China emerging as one of the world’s largest economies. As a result, there is growing anticipation that the renminbi will play a significant role in the global reserve currency system. Shifting to a multicurrency system could reduce the burden on a single reserve currency like the U.S. dollar and allow countries to diversify their foreign exchange holdings.



In the start, the role of renminbi was restricted to domestic use only within a controlled economy. It wasn’t highly recognized at international level then. In the second half of the 20th century, under Deng Xiaoping, when China moved towards market reforms, renminbi went through substantial changes. In 1980s, the government of China introduced dual-track system which allowed only limited foreign exchange under firm control. China centralized its exchange rate system by 1994, leading to globalization.

The Second International Conference on “The Right to Return: Advancing Justice for Azerbaijanis Expelled from Armenia” was held on December 5–6, 2024, in Baku, Azerbaijan. Organized by the Western Azerbaijan Community (WAC), the event brought together over 200 participants from 51 countries, including members of parliament, public and political figures, civil society activists, academics, and representatives from 25 diplomatic missions. The conference sought to address the multifaceted challenges associated with forced displacement and to explore pathways for strengthening the right to return for Azerbaijanis forcibly expelled from Armenia.

In his address to the conference

attendees, President Ilham Aliyev highlighted the enduring consequences of forcible displacement, affecting over 120 million people globally, including hundreds of thousands of Azerbaijanis expelled from their historical homeland in Western Azerbaijan, present-day Armenia. The deportations, occurring during distinct periods such as 1918–1921, 1948–1953, and 1987–1991, led to the complete ethnic cleansing of Azerbaijanis from Armenia, rendering it a mono-ethnic state. President Aliyev underscored that these deportations were accompanied by the systematic destruction of Azerbaijani cultural heritage, including mosques, cemeteries, and historical sites, in an attempt to erase Azerbaijani identity.
