





Mr. Akram called for a collective national strategy to combat global terrorism, emphasizing that effective solutions require sustainable government initiatives and educational reforms to tackle the root causes of extremism. In the second half of the segment, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram addressed the continuing Israeli military attacks on humanitarian zones in Gaza, which have led to escalating casualties. On 29 January 2025, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram, Executive Director of the Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF), was invited as a guest on FM 98 Dosti Channel in Islamabad for a live interview on the program 'HUM QADAM.' During the discussion, Mr. Akram focused on the groundbreaking emergence of DeepSeek, a Chinese AI startup that has quickly made a significant impact in the multi-billion-dollar AI market. Founded in late 2023 by serial entrepreneur Mr. Liang Wenfeng in Hangzhou, China. DeepSeek has garnered attention for demonstrating that high-performing AI models can be developed with comparatively modest investments. Remarkably, the development team indicated they spent less than \$6 million on computing power—far less than the astronomical budgets typically allocated by leading U.S. tech giants like OpenAI and Google, creators of ChatGPT and Gemini. Mr. Akram emphasized that DeepSeek's rapid rise challenges the conventional wisdom regarding the overwhelming dominance of Silicon Valley in AI technology. The company's success raises critical questions about the sustainability of the inflated market valuations of established firms like Nvidia and Meta.



War, i.e. the Allies which included Soviet Union, USA, UK, France and imperial China. The purported and projected objects of the UN Charter were to prohibit aggression as a means of resolution of international disputes and ensure national independence and integrity through the system of collective security. The UN Charter had anticipated that in future if disputes and violence at international level were to be prevented, a just system of global Governance would have to be put in place on permanent basis. However, the Charter's attempt to make provisions for an effective system of Global Governance remained inchoate and was further curtailed by the power of veto given under the Charter to the permanent members of the Security Council—the Allies. It may however be clarified that the international



normative framework as framed through UN and its subordinate agencies in the matters of international economic and trade rules, environmental protection, anti-terrorism and international security aligns with the vision of CSFM. The sticking point is the effective implementation of the joint agenda through the aegis of the UN where the existence of the veto powers becomes a stumbling block.
