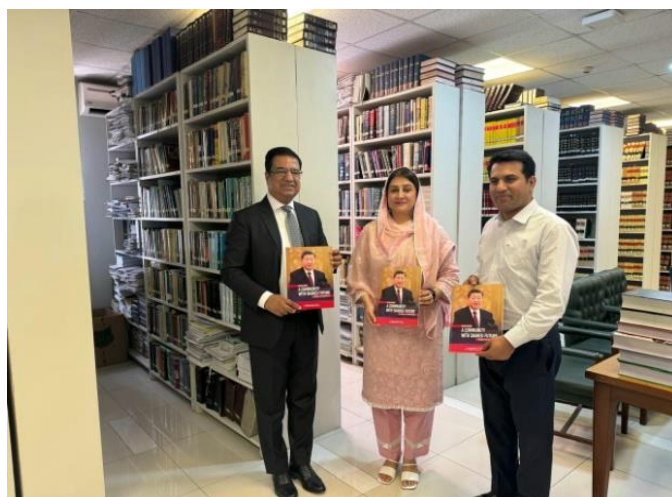
## **Book Presentation at Law and Justice Commission of Pakistan**

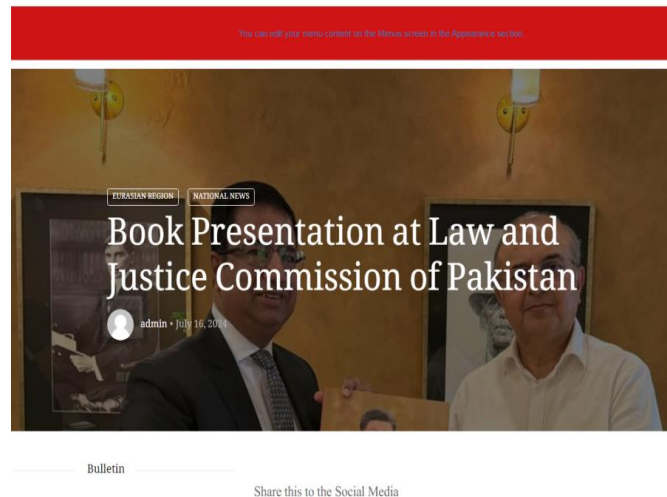

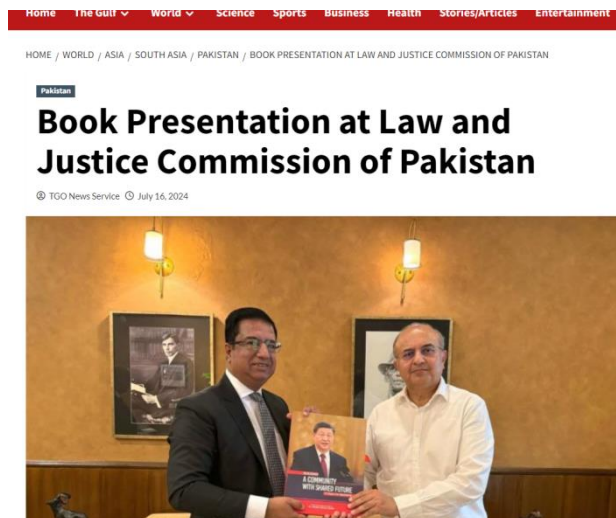

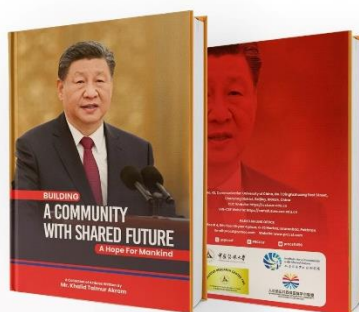

On 10 July 2024, The International Conference on the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), themed "CPEC: Enhancing Community with a Shared Future for Mankind," was held in Islamabad, bringing together distinguished guests, experts, and policymakers to explore the vast potential and strategic significance of CPEC. The conference was jointly organized by the Ministry of Planning, Development and Special Initiatives, the Embassy of the People's Republic of China, Communication University, Beijing, and the Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future.

Governor Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Faisal Karim Kundi, the chief guest of the conference, described CPEC as a game changer that will revolutionize the industrial sector and create





new growth opportunities. He acknowledged the pivotal role of President Asif Ali Zardari in CPEC's inception and highlighted the project's potential to transform the lives of millions through technological collaboration with China. Governor Kundi reaffirmed the time-tested friendship between China and Pakistan and expressed optimism about CPEC's positive impact on the regional economy.

Mr. Sumra highlighted ongoing projects like the development of Gwadar Port and Free Trade Zone, which are pivotal for regional trade and economic integration. Muhammad Asim Khan, Head of Development Communication, Ministry of Planning,



Development, and Special Initiatives, highlighted the strategic significance of CPEC and its transformative impact on Pakistan's infrastructure and energy sectors. He outlined the conference's objectives, including fostering cooperation on industrial relocation, transport infrastructure, and



environmental sustainability. Mr. Khan emphasized the socio-economic benefits of CPEC Phase II, which focuses on human development, agricultural cooperation, and regional integration. He expressed gratitude to all participants and emphasized the importance of collaborative efforts in realizing CPEC's potential.

Senator Sarmad Ali, speaking on "The Role of Media in Enhancing Regional Connectivity

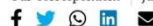

Today, Kumbum Monastery serves as a major center of Tibetan Buddhist learning and continues to attract visitors from around the world.

On 23 July 2024, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram visited the Chaka Salt Lake in Ulan County, Haixi Prefecture, Qinghai Province, China. Chaka Salt Lake is a salt lake in Ulan County, Haixi Mongol and Tibetan Prefecture, Qinghai, China. The oval-shaped lake is located near the eastern end of Qaidam Basin, 298 kilometres to the west of the provincial capital Xining. The name "Chaka" means "Salt Lake" in Tibetan language.

Chaka Salt Lake occupies an important position in the Belt and Road Initiative. It is an important station of the ancient Silk Road and the Tang-Fan Ancient Road. In the scenic area, you can see the Prayer Flag Square, Oboo, and ethnic performing arts activities, which are very distinctive. The lake is famous for its crystal-blue water and reflective lake bed, and is popularly known as "Mirror of the Sky".

**July 23, 2024**



On 25th July 2024, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram visited the world-famous Qinghai Lake located in Qinghai Province, China. This is the largest lake in China and the Eurasian Region, approximately 4,000 km<sup>2</sup> in size with a length of 107 km and a width of 63 km, and a maximum depth of about 25 meters. It has a long recorded history.

During the Han dynasty (206 BCE – 220 CE), significant numbers of Han Chinese lived in the Xining valley to the east of China. In the 17th century, Mongolic-speaking Oirat and Khalkha tribes migrated to Qinghai and became known as Qinghai Mongols. In 1724, the Qinghai Mongols, led by Lobzang Danjin, revolted against the Qing dynasty. The Qing dynasty, after suppressing the rebellion, revoked Qinghai's autonomy and imposed direct rule. Although some Tibetans lived around the lake, the Qing maintained an administrative division dating back to the time of Gūshi Khan between the Dalai Lama's western realm (slightly smaller than the current Tibet Autonomous Region) and the Tibetan-inhabited areas in the east. Yongzheng also sent Manchu and Han settlers to assimilate with the Mongols.





During Nationalist rule (1928–1949), the Han population formed the majority of Qinghai Province's residents, while Chinese Muslims (Hui) dominated the government. The Kuomintang Hui general Ma Bufang, after inviting Kazakh Muslims, along with the governor of Qinghai and other high-ranking Qinghai and national government officials, conducted a joint Kokonuur Lake Ceremony to worship the God of the Lake. During the ritual, the Chinese national anthem was sung, and all participants bowed to a Portrait of Kuomintang founder Sun Yat-sen as well as to the God of the Lake.

After the 1949 Chinese revolution, refugees from the Anti-Rightist Movement of the 1950s settled in the area to the west of Qinghai Lake. Following the Chinese economic reforms in the 1980s, attracted by new business opportunities, migration to the area increased, leading to ecological stresses. Fresh grass production in Gangcha County north of the lake declined from an average of 2,057 kilograms per hectare (1,835 lb/acre) to 1,271 kg/ha (1,134 lb/acre) in 1987. In 2001, the State Forestry Administration of China initiated the "Retire Cropland, Restore Grasslands" project in the area surrounding the lake.

On 27th July 2024, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram, Executive Director, Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF) was invited as a keynote speaker at the International Conference on “Mutual Learning of Civilizations and Cultural Cooperation: The Practice of a Community with a Shared Future for Mankind at Hilton Hotel in Xining City, Qinghai Province. He emphasised that these initiatives align with the Belt and Road Initiative's goals of extending ancient exchanges along the Silk Road into a modern framework and fostering collaboration and cooperation among civilisations.

The conference epitomized international cooperation, bringing together over 200 experts and scholars from countries such as Sri Lanka, Malaysia, Rwanda, Italy, and others, fostering the collective spirit of a shared future. The conference serves as a significant platform in the region, highlighting the crucial role of intercultural dialogue in addressing diverse global issues and promoting harmony among various communities.

## Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram invited as Keynote speaker on the 8th Anniversary of the Defeated Coup Attempt in Türkiye

July 15, 2024



On 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram, Executive Director of the Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future, participated as a keynote speaker in the commemoration ceremony for the 8th anniversary of the 2016 defeated coup attempt in Türkiye. The event was arranged at the Embassy of the Republic of Türkiye at Islamabad and was attended by a large number of people including Ahmed Naseem Warriach, Additional Secretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Pakistan.

Addressing the event, Türkiye's Ambassador Dr. Mehmet Paçacı stated that this year's ceremony for Democracy and National Unity Day centered around the theme of "Victory of the Nation." He highlighted that it has been eight years since the coup attempt orchestrated by the Fethullah Gulen Terrorist Organization (FETO),



which resulted in the martyrdom of 251 citizens and injuries to over 2000 others.

Dr. Paçacı described FETO as not only a terrorist organization but also an espionage entity with cult-like characteristics, initially presenting itself as a religious movement promoting education and inter-religious dialogue. However, it concealed its malevolent intentions through

systematic infiltration into the military, law enforcement, judiciary, and various government institutions over decades, culminating in the full-scale plot unleashed on July 15, 2016. Ambassador Paçacı credited the Turkish people for thwarting the threat posed by FETO that night, demonstrating their unwavering commitment to their sovereignty and readiness to defend the state and its democratic achievements. Thousands of civilians courageously took to the streets to halt the coup attempt, with prayers for the martyrs and gratitude extended to veterans and distinguished guests.

Highlighting the international threat posed by FETO, Ambassador Paçacı underscored its ambitions to influence political and economic spheres, operating without regard for host countries' laws and functioning akin to a criminal and intelligence organization. He praised Pakistan for swiftly acting against FETO affiliates following the treacherous coup attempt, noting Pakistan's designation of FETO as a proscribed organization in December 2018. He reaffirmed Türkiye's resolute stance against the FETO International Network and emphasized the universal fight against terrorism, asserting that terrorism transcends language, religion, and race. Ambassador Paçacı concluded by honoring Türkiye's historic leaders, including Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, and expressing gratitude to President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan for his leadership during the coup attempt.



Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram stated that the events of July 15th serve as a reminder of the importance of safeguarding democratic principles and preserving the unity of the nation. He emphasized that the entire nation stood against heavily armed plotters and, with the support of the majority of the military and police forces, quashed the coup attempt in less than 24 hours. The courage and bravery of the martyrs remain vivid in our minds and will continue to inspire future generations. Mr. Khalid affirmed that Pakistan, as Turkey's steadfast ally, stands shoulder-to-shoulder with the Turkish people, paying tribute to the heroes who laid down their lives for the security and stability of their beloved nation. He praised the determination and willpower displayed by the people of Türkiye, calling it truly inspirational and a beacon of hope for many around the world.

Speaking on the occasion, Pakistan's Additional Foreign Secretary for West Asia and Afghanistan, Ahmad Naseem Warriach, who was also the chief guest, remarked that on July 15, 2016, the entire world witnessed the courage and bravery of the heroes and people of Turkiye. "They demonstrated their resilience and the strength of their democracy. It is their contribution that we see continuing with the progress of Turkiye." He reiterated Pakistan's firm solidarity with Turkiye and reaffirmed Pakistan's commitment to their shared vision for peace, progress, and prosperity for both countries.
