**Special Lecture delivered by Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram on "Corporate Law in the Age of CPEC: Legal Frameworks Driving Business Expansion and Investment" during a Taxation Workshop at Islamabad**

**29 June 2025**



On 29th June 2025, M. Khalid Taimur Akram, Executive Director, Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF) delivered a significant lecture during a Taxation Workshop held in Islamabad from June 29 to July 1, 2025. The workshop was organized by Advocate Gulsher Mari Balouch, an Advocate of the High Court and specialist in taxation and corporate law, and Advocate Atuba Shahid. Mr. Akram's presentation, titled "Corporate Law in the Age of CPEC: Legal Frameworks Driving Business Expansion and Investment," focused on the critical relevance of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), a flagship project of China's broader Belt and Road Initiative (BRI).

Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram lecture specifically addressed the legal taxation framework and related taxation policies. He highlighted the "Regional Taxation Framework" as a significant challenge to regional connectivity, noting the absence of a unified financial and legal framework, as well as the presence of diverse trade policies and tariff structures. While the summary provided does



not offer detailed insights into the specific legal taxation framework or particular taxation policies discussed, it indicates these were central to his presentation.

Furthermore, Mr. Akram explored various aspects of the BRI and CPEC, emphasizing their direct implications for corporate law and the foundational frameworks necessary for fostering business expansion and investment within this dynamic geopolitical and economic landscape. It is likely that he outlined how existing corporate legal structures in the region interact with the demands and opportunities presented by the substantial infrastructure and economic projects under CPEC. The discussion would have covered regulatory environments that either encourage or hinder foreign direct investment and overall business growth, thus providing a foundation for a comprehensive examination of the fiscal policies governing these activities.

The lecture garnered a diverse audience, including students, tax experts, legal scholars, and business leaders, fostering lively discussions during the interactive session.

China's forward-looking diplomatic vision and step have once again been realized through the establishment of the International Organization for Mediation (IOMed), a global initiative that seeks to reshape the existing frameworks for international dispute resolution by introducing a peaceful, inclusive, and consensus-driven alternative to the long-dominant litigation and arbitration models. It was precisely in this spirit that, three years ago, China began close collaboration with nearly 20 like-minded countries to craft the foundation of a new institution that would champion harmony and mutual understanding, and these cumulative efforts culminated on May 30, 2025, with the formal signing of the Convention on the Establishment of IOMed in Hong Kong, a landmark event that brought together more than 400 high-level representatives from 85 countries and 20 international organizations across continents, with 33 nations signing the document as founding member states. It is a significant shift in the evolution of global governance at a time when geopolitical polarization, unilateralism, and institutional collapse threaten international stability. This significant development is not only a testament to China's steadfast commitment to promoting a community with a shared future for mankind but also a response to a pressing global necessity, as there is a lack of a dedicated, institutionalized global body for mediation, despite mediation being explicitly recognized in Article 33 of the United Nations Charter as one of the primary peaceful means of settling disputes between states.

This article outlines the following: Following the landmark India-Pakistan ceasefire agreement in May 2025, Prime Minister Shahbaz Sharif embarked on a strategic four-nation diplomatic tour—visiting Türkiye, Iran, Azerbaijan, and Tajikistan—to strengthen regional ties, acknowledge international support, and promote peace and stability.

In Türkiye, he held high-level talks with President Erdogan, focusing on defense, energy, and trade cooperation while expressing gratitude for Ankara's steadfast support during tensions with India.

In Iran, discussions with President Masoud Pezeshkian and Supreme Leader Khamenei centered on trade, border security, and regional connectivity, alongside a peace overture to India on Kashmir and counterterrorism.

The Azerbaijan leg included a trilateral summit with Türkiye and Azerbaijan to boost strategic ties, economic partnerships, and cultural exchanges, alongside tributes to Karabakh martyrs.

Finally, in Tajikistan, Sharif signed a Strategic Partnership Agreement, supported mutual UNSC candidacies, and participated in a glacier preservation conference, underscoring shared environmental and security concerns.

Across all visits, the PM emphasized multilateral cooperation through platforms like the SCO and OIC, reinforced economic and security collaboration, and positioned Pakistan as a proactive advocate for regional stability, leveraging diplomacy to consolidate post-ceasefire gains and foster long-term partnerships.

In 2024, clean energy sources had generated nearly 40% of China's electricity, a great step in decarbonizing its economy. The country's leadership has enabled clean energy sources to account for nearly half of global employment in the renewable energy sector.

China boasts the world's largest and most complete renewable energy industrial chain, producing over 70% of the world's solar photovoltaic (PV) panels and leading global production of wind turbines and hydropower equipment. Dominance in new energy vehicles (NEVs) and lithium-ion batteries has also transformed international markets. For ten consecutive years, China has led the world in NEV production and sales, with exports surpassing 2 million units in 2024 alone, which led to the creation of 46% of global renewable energy jobs, according to international reports, making China a driver of green employment and low-carbon economic worldwide.

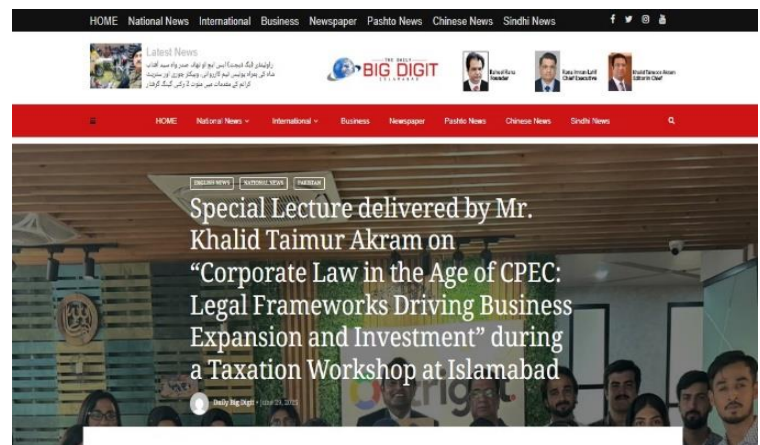
