

The Initiative of Belt and Road (BRI), also well-known as the New Silk Road, is a huge infrastructure project that is being undertaken by the Chinese government. The formation of a physical construction among East Asia and Europe was the initial goal that they focused on. Since that time, China's political and economic power has significantly increased as a result of the program's expansion to South America, Africa, and Oceania. As a result of the skyrocketing costs for a variety of projects, the plan has been subjected to criticism from other nations. Some experts view it as a dangerous continuation of China's expanding power. The US and other Asian nations are worried that the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) may obscure China's efforts to expand its military presence and expand its regional presence.



Silk Road development took time. Cultural exchange, trade, and idea exchange influenced it for millennia. China calls the BRI “One Belt One Road”. Sometimes called the “New Silk Road”. BRI is China's 2013 global infrastructure plan. It will invest in 150+ nations and organisations. Chinese President Xi Jinping says "it is believed to be the focal point of the country's foreign policy". BRI supports the concept of "Major Country Diplomacy" coined by Xi 5 www.prccsf.com Jinping. This policy has the objective of empowering China to lead global affairs as its prominence develops, like the US Marshall Plan. In August 2023, 155 countries joined the BRI. Over 75% of the globe's inhabitants and 50% of Revenue are in member countries. Xi Jinping introduced the "Silk Road Economic Belt" in September 2013 during his Diplomatic visit to “Kazakhstan”.

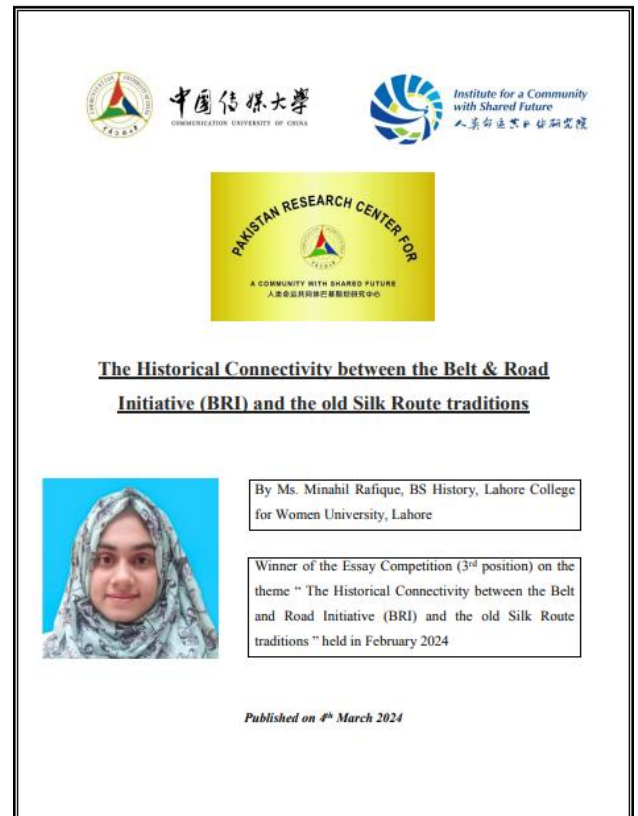

In 2013, the Belt and Road Initiative (or BRI), the Chinese President Xi Jinping bestowed upon this name. It is related historically to Old Silk Route Traditions. BRI is also termed as New Silk Road. Both Old and New Silk routes involve extensive trade networks facilitating cultural and economic exchange across different regions. Just like the Silk Route, the objective of BRI is to improve cooperation, connections between nations. Old Silk Route origins in Han Dynasty (206BCE-220CE), expanding under Emperor Wu's initiative. This ancient trade network connected East and West. This is one of the oldest and most Influential trade networks in history. The Han Dynasty establishes the Silk Route to facilitate trade with Central Asia and beyond, introducing Chinese silk to the wider world. The name given to this route Silk Road because from 4th century BC to 2nd century AD, the main item in trade was Silk. The Trade route was geopolitically important, so much that every power in region aspired to have dominance on this route. Charles C Mann believe that it was indeed the Asian inventions such as paper, gunpowder, stirrup and moldboard plow which led to the bigger technological innovations in the West.

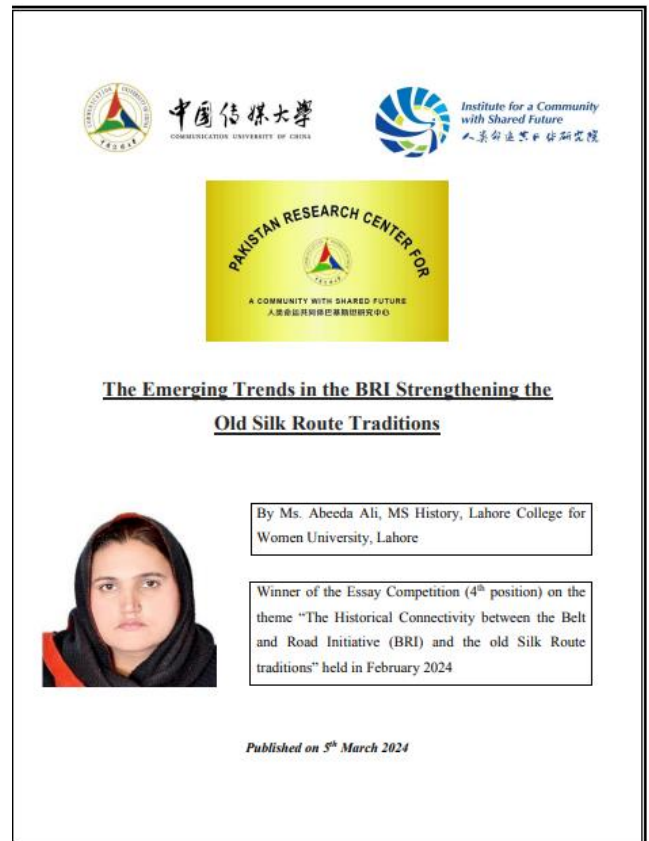
The Emerging Trends in the BRI Strengthening the Old Silk Route Traditions

The Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) announced by the Chinese government in 2013, is the re-emergence of the historical Silk Route. The ‘Silk Route’ was the route connecting the East and the West; it connected Asia, Europe and Africa. However, according to Man Hung Thomas Chan, the term itself is not much older, as it was coined in the nineteenth century. The route served as a conduit primarily for goods, however, ideas, religions, culture and social values were also the secondary commodities of the exchange. These traditions of the Silk Route are finding their reinvigoration in the modern era. The BRI is reviving the exchange significance of the historical Silk Route; it is helping to exchange goods, values, cultures and ideas between the East and the West. BRI comprises 140 countries and 30 international

organizations, so it enjoys a much wider outreach than its historical predecessor. As the Silk Route in the classic period promoted the exchange of goods, that's exactly what the modern prototype is attempting to do. Cheap Chinese products are gaining wider acceptance in the global market. The net worth of its investments consists of \$ 1 trillion in infrastructure investments comprising transport, energy, information technology (IT), mining, special economic zones (SEZs) and “smart cities.

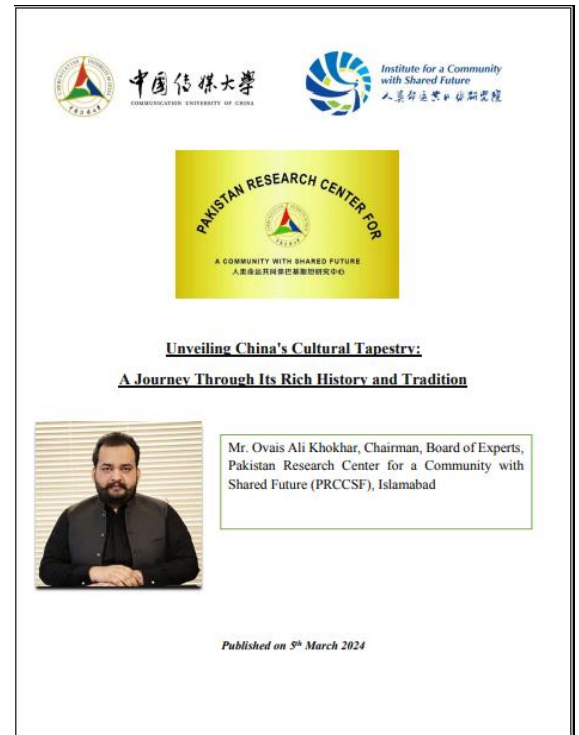

Chinese leadership is enhancing all efforts to widen market access, level the playing field further, and smooth the flow of innovation factors, all aimed at shoring up foreign investor confidence in developing businesses in China and boosting the quality and level of trade and investment cooperation. Last year, in July 2023, China's Ministry of Commerce (MOFCOM) called for a roundtable system to improve communication between government departments, foreign-funded enterprises, and foreign business associations by holding roundtable discussions. And in August 2023, Chinese government guidelines issuance to attract foreign investment will further optimize and foster the investment environment by putting forward 24 points across six aspects, such as improving the quality of foreign capital utilization and strengthening foreign investment. China's Ministry of Commerce stated that the number of newly established foreign-invested enterprises has increased significantly in the first month of 2024; 4,588 new foreign-invested firms were established across China, up 74.4 percent year on year, showcasing the increasing attraction of the Chinese market. Optimizing the business environment has become the consensus of local governments to promote economic development, with Shanghai and eastern provinces like Zhejiang and Fujian introducing specific measures to attract foreign investment.
