Three-Day International Conference on “South & Central Asia Re-Connected” held at University of the Punjab, Lahore

8th –10th May 2023



A three-day international conference (8th–10th May 2023) on "South and Central Asia Re-Connected" was held. It was organized by the Department of History and Pakistan Studies, University of the Punjab, Lahore, at Al Raazi Hall.

The conference was aimed at emphasizing the need for cooperation between South Asia and Central Asia to address common issues faced by both regions, such as security, extremism, and climatic and environmental issues. It was aimed at enhancing people-to-people connectivity, trade and investment, and the exchange of ideas and knowledge. The experts highlighted how regional connectivity is crucial to unlocking the potential of this diverse and dynamic region. They also suggested how security, extremism, and climatic and environmental issues could be resolved by the two regions. The international conference featured significant plenary sessions and interactive discussions. The inaugural session of the conference was addressed by renowned experts, academicians, and analysts.

On Day 1, Mr. Khalid Taimoor Akram, Executive Director, Pakistan Research Centre for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF), presented a speech on "Regional Organisations and Institutions (SCO)". He stated that the SCO is a potent multilateral institution and a conducive platform for the member states to maintain peace and stability and also promote cultural, educational, and scientific exchange.

He said that SCO promotes cultural exchanges and cooperation and also further expands bilateral and multilateral trade, promoting broader and more practical multilateral security cooperation. SCO is an inalienable part of Central and South Asia and a bridge between them. South Asia is actively involved in the SCO's role in connecting South and Central Asian cooperation. Expanding cultural interactions within



the SCO region, strengthening mutual understanding among its peoples, respecting their cultural traditions and customs, and preserving and enhancing cultural diversity within SCO member states remain top priorities aimed at promoting harmony and ensuring security and sustainable development.

Adding to his speech, he stated that cooperation between the authorities of SCO member states is based on common interests rather than being the tool of one member state's geopolitical ambition. In the end, he concluded his remarks by saying that SCO countries work together and develop a shared sense of identity and purpose. The participants discussed how to achieve long-term peace and stability and gave new ideas for multilateral economic cooperation in the SCO domains. On Day 2, Mr. Khalid Taimoor Akram, ED, PRCCSF, chaired an informative session titled "Regional Security: Threats of Jihadism, Drugs and Arms Trafficking, and Climate Change."

The session convened prominent experts, policymakers, and academics from diverse fields who shared their insights and expertise on the critical challenges facing our region

in the domains of security, terrorism, organized crime, and environmental concerns. They emphasized the need for collaborative efforts at regional levels to address them effectively. They also guided the discussions and facilitated the exploration of comprehensive strategies to tackle these multifaceted issues.

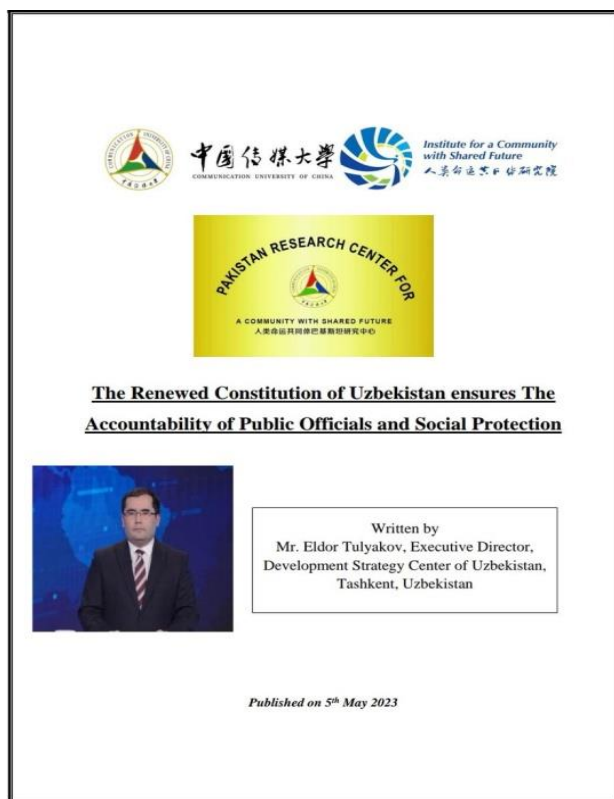

Uzbekistan has recently held a referendum on adopting the new version of the Constitution by nationwide voting. An important political event attracted millions of Uzbek citizens, which resulted in the participation of 84.51 per cent of the population who had the right to vote.

At the same time, more than half of the norms included in the new Constitution aim to strengthen the guarantees and mechanisms for protecting human rights and freedoms. The changes to the new Constitution of Uzbekistan should further support the social well-being of persons and increase the accountability of state bodies.

4. "Post conflict & Ecological Condition of the Jabrayil Region in the Post-Occupation Period"

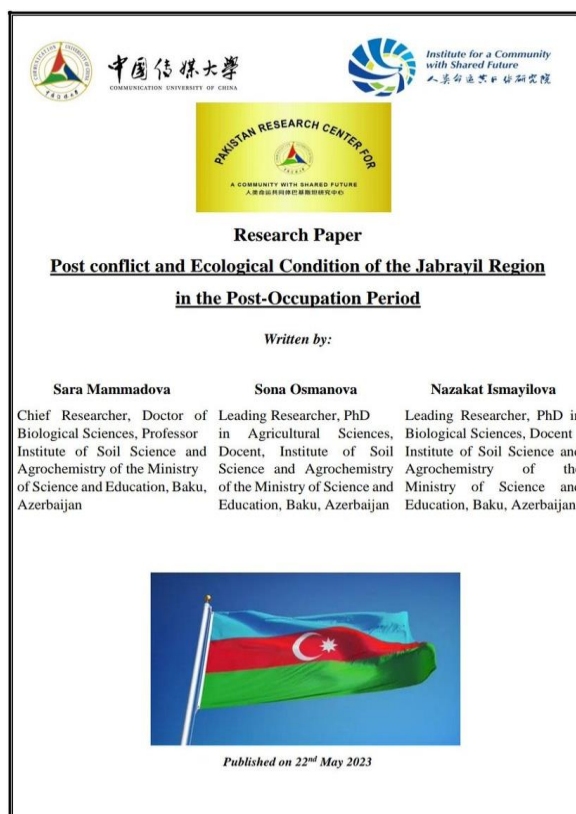

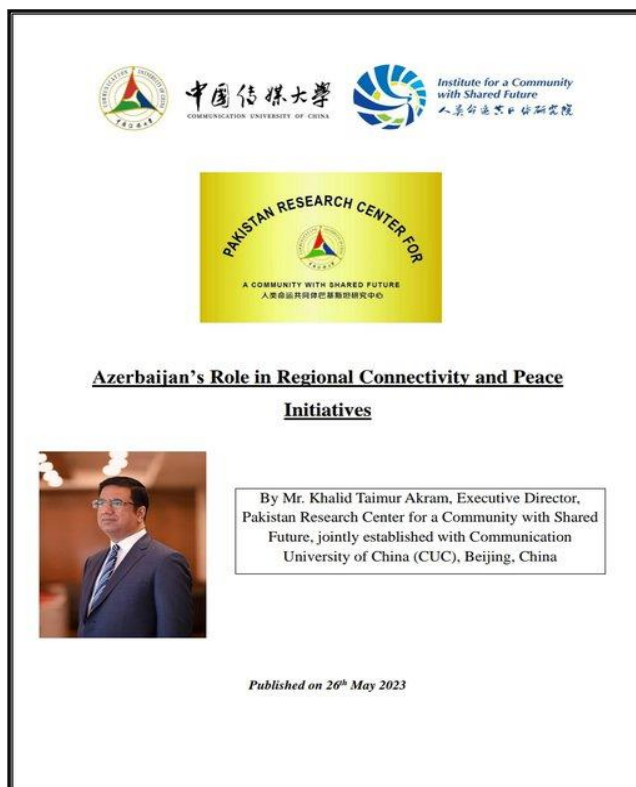

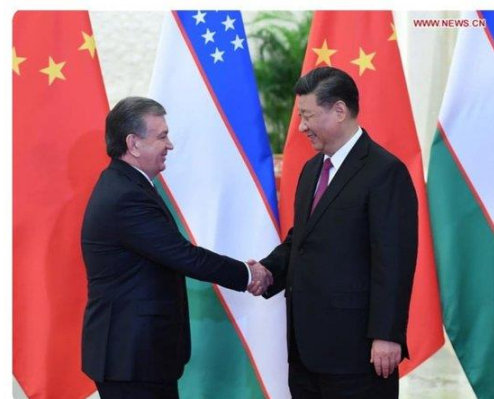

On May 23, 2023, School of Politics and International Relations (SPIR), Quaid-i-Azam University, Islamabad, in collaboration with the Embassy of the People’s Republic of China and Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF) to Pakistan, organized a seminar with a sole purpose of integrating national and international intellectuals and scholars to discuss the Chinese governance model, reforms, global developments advancing the concept of a Community with Shared future, dialogue of civilization, and socio-economic transformation under Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) and most specifically China – Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC).

It was followed by the opening remarks of Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram, who is an Executive Director of PRCCSF, who presented a copy of the book *Governance of China*, authored by Chinese President Xi Jinping. Welcome remarks from the Chinese delegates were given by Professor Li Huailiang, who is a Dean of the Institute for a Community with Shared Future, Communication



University of China (CUC), Beijing, China. He emphasized explaining how China is a driving force for economic development in the region and connecting the world. Dr. Jaspal then presented his talk on China's contemporary global world order, explaining how Great Powers rejuvenated the alliances and China's role in establishing peace and harmony between the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the Islamic Republic of Iran. Moreover, he explained how China is hammering Geoeconomics rather than geostrategic factors through its Chinese investments in Pakistan and the region, and projects like the CPEC are a source of immense value for Pakistan, Afghanistan, and the other states in the region. In such circumstances, we must determine how to harness cooperation dividends for our economic prosperity. Dr. Dou Yulei, Associate Professor, School of Economics and Management, Communication University of China (CUC), through the virtual address, shed light on President Xi Jinping's perspective of a



community with a shared future and the concept of dialogue among civilizations, considering that.

Professor Wang Sixin, Deputy Dean of the ICSF, Communication University of China, talked about China Global Development Initiative and the way forward for the



International Community and enlightened the audience on how the Chinese government

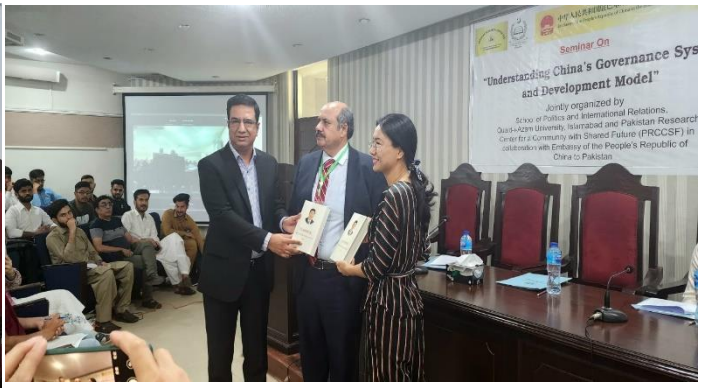
is making efforts as a peace broker by creating economic linkages, binding the nations together.

He explained cultural cooperation as a tool for soft-power projection with a case study of China and Pakistan. Later, a concise speech by Mr. Saifullah



Danishwar from the University of Punjab, Lahore, Pakistan, elucidated how BRI is seen as a tool for connecting partner countries: Ms. Liu Bei, a Ph.D. Scholar from the Institute for International and Area Studies (IIAS), Tsinghua University, Beijing, chronicled the role of media in generating and increasing narratives regarding the efficiency of the BRI in connectivity and explained how media from both states, Pakistan and China could help to foster peace and harmony. The seminar concluded with a question and answer session in which participants from both Pakistan and China exchanged keenness and enthusiasm.

The Seminar was attended by the faculty members of SPIR, PRCCSF researchers, Chinese Embassy officials, print and electronic media reporters and nearly 100 hundred undergraduate and post grade students.

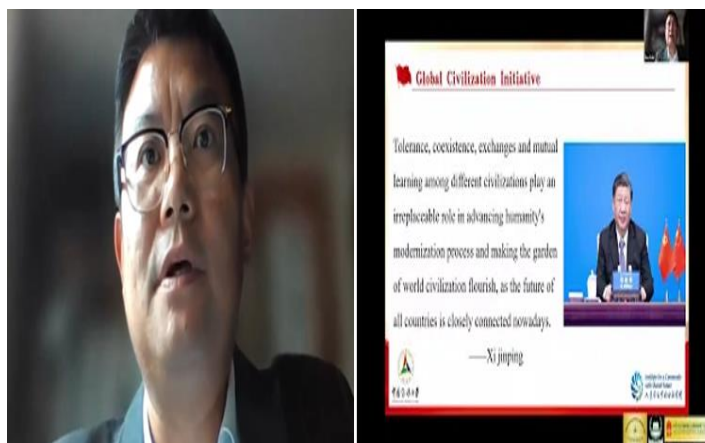
