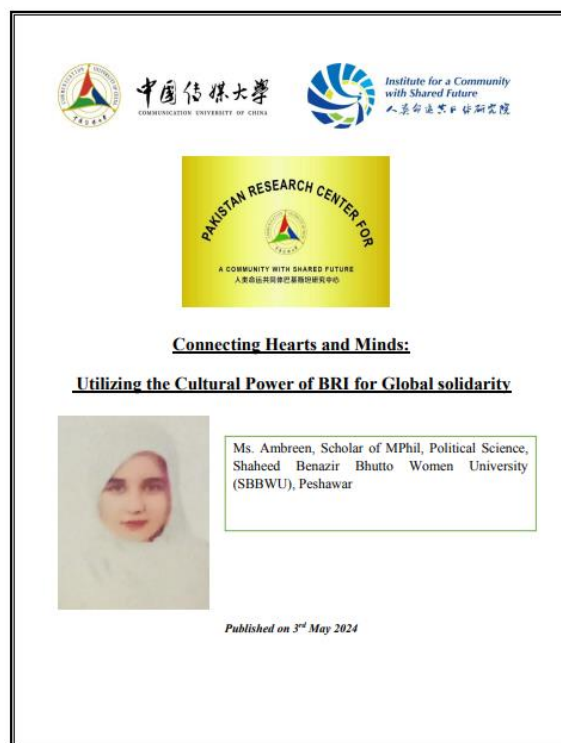
Connecting Hearts and Minds: Utilizing the Cultural Power of BRI for Global solidarity
