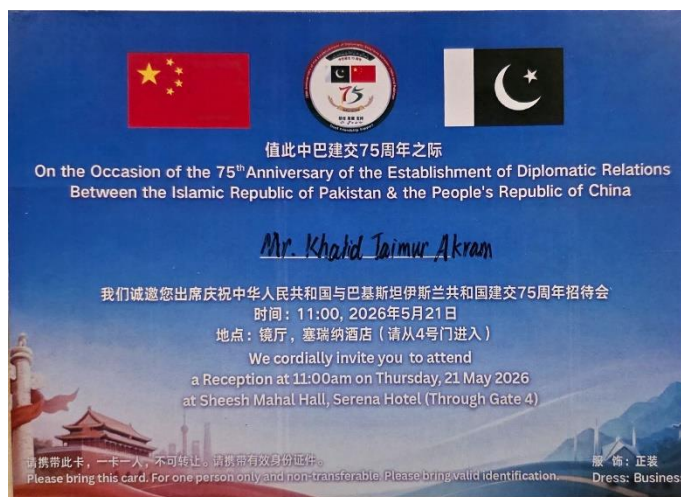
between the two countries, which has remained a model of mutual trust, strategic partnership, and unwavering cooperation for over seven decades.

ICSF–UoS Fellowship Program 2025–26 Concludes with China Fellowship Award

Ceremony at University of Sargodha

On May 5, 2026, the China Fellowship Award Ceremony was successfully held at the University of Sargodha (UoS) to mark the completion of the ICSF–UoS Fellowship Program 2025–26. The event recognized the valuable contributions of participants, faculty members, speakers, and program management team.

The six-month fellowship program was organized by the Institute for a Community with Shared Future (ICSF) at Communication University of China, Beijing, in collaboration with the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Pakistan. Running from October 14, 2025, to April 28, 2026, the program aimed to strengthen academic exchange, research collaboration, and cultural understanding between Pakistan and China.



The award ceremony was jointly organized by the Pakistan Institute of China Studies (PICS-UoS) and the Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF), Islamabad, in collaboration with the Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Pakistan.
