



The Guest of Honour, H.E. Shaza Fatima Khawaja, Federal Minister for Information Technology and Telecommunication, appreciated the growing partnership between Pakistan and Kazakhstan. She emphasized the importance of digital cooperation, innovation, and youth engagement in strengthening bilateral ties and promoting regional development.



Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram delivered his presentation under Theme II: “The Foreign Policy Course of President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev”, where he discussed Kazakhstan’s balanced and multi-

vector foreign policy approach under President Tokayev. He highlighted Kazakhstan's role as a bridge between Central and South Asia and underscored Pakistan's strategic importance in promoting regional peace, connectivity, and sustainable development. He also emphasized enhancing economic cooperation, trade linkages, and people-to-people exchanges under the framework of the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI).



In his opening remarks, H.E. Mr. Yerzhan Kistafin, Ambassador of Kazakhstan to Pakistan, emphasized the deep-rooted friendship and mutual trust between the two nations. Theme II: The Foreign Policy Course of President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev • Sergey Savelyev, Senior Expert from the Institute of Foreign Policy Studies under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Kazakhstan (online), elaborated on Kazakhstan’s multi-vector diplomacy, promoting peaceful coexistence, economic cooperation, and international dialogue.

The Gulf Observer (Affiliated Media House of PRCCSF), The Gulf Observer Research Forum and the Embassy of Turkmenistan in Islamabad Hold Round Table Conference on 30 Years of Turkmenistan’s Permanent Neutrality

On October 28, 2025, The Gulf Observer, The Gulf Observer Research Forum and the Embassy of the Republic of Turkmenistan in Pakistan, organized a Round Table Conference at the National Language Promotion Department (NLPD), Islamabad, to commemorate the 30th Anniversary of Turkmenistan’s Permanent Neutrality—a cornerstone of Turkmenistan’s foreign policy and a beacon of peace, dialogue, and cooperation in the modern world.

The distinguished gathering brought together diplomats, scholars, journalists, policymakers, and intellectuals from across Pakistan and abroad. The event symbolized the growing intellectual and cultural partnership between Pakistan and Turkmenistan, rooted in shared history, regional cooperation, and mutual respect.

The conference was graced by the Chief Guest His Excellency Atadjan Movlamov,



Ambassador of Turkmenistan to Pakistan, who was warmly received by Dr. Rashid Hameed, Executive Director of the NLPD and Mr. Muhammad Ali Pasha, Patron-in-Chief of The Gulf Observer, and later, H.E. Mohammad Yahya, United Nations Resident Coordinator (UNRC) in Pakistan, was also welcomed by Mr. Muhammad Ali Pasha, Dr. Rashid Hameed, and The Gulf Observer's Editor-in-Chief Ms. Fatima Tuz Zehra. The proceedings commenced with the national anthems of Turkmenistan and Pakistan, followed by the recitation of the Holy Quran by Hafiz Inam.



Dr. Rashid Hameed, in his opening remarks, extended his profound respect to His Excellency Qurbanquly Berdimuhamedov, the National Leader of the Turkmen People, and His Excellency Serdar Berdimuhamedov, the President of Turkmenistan, praising their leadership in guiding Turkmenistan toward sustainable development, cultural advancement, and international diplomacy anchored in peace and neutrality. A recorded message from Ms. Derya Soysal (Brussels) highlighted Turkmenistan's unwavering commitment to neutrality and international peacebuilding.



Following this, Ms. Yusra Binte Nisar, Research Assistant at Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF), elaborated on Turkmenistan's diplomatic philosophy of neutrality, while Mr. Imran Yousaf emphasized that neutrality, as practiced by Turkmenistan, is a conscious choice for dialogue over division and peace over conflict.

Dr. Ghazala Khan, representing the National Vocational & Technical Training Commission (NAVTTTC), drew parallels between Turkmenistan’s human-centric development approach and Pakistan’s vision for youth empowerment and skills training.

Mr. Hammad Hassan added that neutrality represents not weakness but wisdom — the courage to pursue cooperation in an increasingly polarized world.

In her concluding note Ms. Fatima Tuz Zehra, Editor-in-Chief of The Gulf Observer, commended Turkmenistan’s



sustained commitment to neutrality under the leadership of His Excellency Gurbanguly Berdimuhamedov and His Excellency Serdar Berdimuhamedov. She noted that December 12, celebrated as Neutrality Day, marks 30 years of the United Nations’ official recognition of Turkmenistan’s neutral status — a principle now enshrined in its Constitution.

Barrister Zopash Khan described Turkmenistan as a “living example of neutrality in action.” He added that our collaboration in initiatives such as TAPI reflects as a share vision for regional development, connectivity and sustainable growth.

Advocate Adil Aziz Qazi, a prominent legal expert, analyzed the Year of Peace and Trust 2025 and its significance in promoting multilateral diplomacy.



Raja Abdul Qayyum, former Director

General of the Directorate of Electronic Media and Publications, shared his impressions of Ashgabat’s cultural heritage and recited Faiz Ahmed Faiz’s poetry on Turkmenistan’s capital.

Veteran journalist Mr. Muhammad Nawaz Raza provided a historical overview, recalling Turkmenistan’s post-independence journey under Saparmurat Niyazov (Turkmenbashi) and its

The event concluded with an interactive question-and-answer session, during which students actively engaged with the speakers and received clarifications on various aspects of the Fellowship Program.




Training Session on Malaysia–China Relations and Environmental Sustainability for China Fellowship Program at the University of Sargodha

The event featured two sessions; a physical lecture by Prof. Dr. Gan Zhang, Director of the State Key Laboratory of Organic Geochemistry and Professor at the Guangzhou Institute of Geochemistry, Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS), and

an online lecture by Dr. Chin Yee Mun, Associate Professor at the Faculty of Creative Industries,



Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman (UTAR), Malaysia, and Director of both the Tun Tan Cheng Lock Institute of Social Studies and the ASEAN Research Center for a Community with Shared Future.

The physical session was formally introduced and moderated by Prof. Dr. Tahir Mumtaz Awan, Director of the Pakistan Institute for China Studies (PICS) and Host Director of the Confucius Institute at the University of Sargodha (UoS), who welcomed the participants and provided an overview of the today's session.



Prof. Gan Zhang delivered an insightful lecture titled “Status of Air Pollution in Asian and African Countries Along the 21st Century Maritime Silk Road.” He discussed the environmental challenges faced by developing nations along the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) route and emphasized the need for joint scientific and policy efforts to address transboundary air pollution.



Highlighting the importance of collaborative research, technological innovation, and evidence-based policymaking, Prof. Zhang called for greater cooperation among BRI countries to promote environmental sustainability and global resilience. His comprehensive presentation engaged the audience in a deep reflection on how environmental protection and sustainable development can reinforce international cooperation.



The session concluded with an interactive question-and-answer segment, during which participants discussed potential collaborative research areas, policy integration, and scientific innovation for addressing regional environmental challenges.

Following the physical lecture, the online training session commenced, moderated and introduced by Ms. Yusra Binte Nisar, Research Assistant at the Pakistan Research Centre for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF), Islamabad.

Dr. Chin Yee Mun commenced his lecture, titled “Malaysia–China Relations through the lens of Humanistic Diplomacy”, by exploring the concept and nature of diplomacy. He elaborated that diplomacy has multiple interpretations depending on the theoretical approach one adopts. He emphasized the realist approach as his main framework for defining diplomacy, explaining how it traditionally focuses on state-centric interests, geopolitical maneuverings, and national interests’ preservation.



Then, he introduced the audience to the concept of humanistic diplomacy, a perspective that goes beyond state-centric paradigms and focuses on people-centered and cooperative approaches to international relations. Drawing upon various scholars and authors, he discussed how humanistic diplomacy emphasizes mutual respect, shared values, multilateralism, and the pursuit of common good among nations.



Using Malaysia–China relations as a case study, Dr. Chin traced the historical trajectory of bilateral relations since 1964, explaining how both countries overcame ideological and political divisions to establish a relationship rooted in mutual trust, respect, and cooperation. He underscored how this partnership, strengthened

through the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), exemplifies the practical application of humanistic diplomacy in fostering regional peace, prosperity, and people-to-people connectivity.

Concluding his presentation, Dr. Chin underscored that the China–Malaysia relationship serves as a living example of diplomacy guided by empathy, cultural understanding, and mutual development rather than zero-sum competition. The online session also concluded with an interactive Q&A discussion, where participants shared their views on the implications of humanistic diplomacy, the evolution of Malaysia–China relations, and the broader role of empathy and cultural understanding in shaping international cooperation.

The joint training session served as a valuable platform for intellectual exchange, uniting diverse academic perspectives on diplomacy, environmental challenges, and transnational collaboration. Both lectures, Prof. Gan Zhang’s insightful discussion on environmental sustainability and Dr. Chin Yee Mun’s profound exploration of humanistic diplomacy and Malaysia-China, offered participants a deeper understanding of global cooperation under the Belt and Road Initiative framework.
