On 18th September 2025, the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Pakistan, in collaboration with the National University of Modern Languages (NUML), organized a seminar titled “Sovereignty and Constitution: Strengthening of the Statehood” held at National University of Modern Languages (NUML), Islamabad. On 26th September 2025, Mr. Khalid Taimur Akram, Executive Director of the Pakistan Research Center for a Community with Shared Future (PRCCSF), participated as a distinguished speaker at the seminar on “27 September – Remembrance Day: The Great Heroism.” The event was jointly organized by NUST Business School (NBS) and the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan to Pakistan at the Heydar Aliyev Auditorium, National University of Sciences and Technology (NUST), Islamabad.







This article highlights how Uzbekistan has transformed the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) from a routine policy checklist into both a domestic reform agenda and a strategic tool of diplomacy. Under President Shavkat Mirziyoyev’s leadership since 2017, Uzbekistan has implemented significant economic reforms—liberalizing foreign exchange, simplifying taxes, and opening the banking system—building a narrative of state capacity and effective “delivery.” Tashkent has paired parliamentary oversight with data-driven progress reviews, presenting the SDGs as an investable brand that resonates internationally.



This approach gained recognition in December 2022 when, at Uzbekistan’s initiative, the UN General Assembly adopted a resolution elevating the role of parliaments in accelerating SDGs, signaling that governance and accountability are as important as the targets themselves. While Uzbekistan’s progress is credible, with the country ranking 62nd out of 167 on the SDG Index with a score of 73.1, further legitimacy will depend on clear definitions, especially regarding poverty, and transparent monitoring that external observers can verify. Overall, Uzbekistan’s SDG strategy reflects a blend of domestic reform, international engagement, and soft-power diplomacy.
